FIRE DRILL - EMERGENCY EVACUATION EXERCISE

On 20 July 2017, K-One conducted a fire drill emergency evacuation exercise at our Ipoh Manufacturing Center involving all our staff.

The main objective of this exercise is to:

- Create staff awareness, alertness and readiness to act during emergency;
- Provide essential knowledge and training for employees to stay composed and know what to do in the event of a fire; and
- Test adequacy of alarm system and PA announcement in all areas.
