PETALING JAYA: Electronic manufacturing services company [K-One Technology Bhd](#)  is planning to start to making medical ventilators.

The company, in a filing with Bursa Malaysia, said it is targeting to commence production in the third quarter of this year.

K-One said it has recently obtained open source design files of a ventilator released by a multinational company.

“The company is studying the ventilator design and intends to build a prototype and expects to commence manufacturing as soon as permissible, targeting the third quarter, subject to getting the necessary approvals from the relevant authorities,” it said.

The ventilator design is one of a series of models marketed by the multinational for a number of years.

The design details were released for production under third party name via permissive licence to meet the high demand globally.

“The company, under its group with ISO 13485 certification specifically meant for medical device manufacturing and Class 10k cleanroom facilities is in a good position to undertake the product portfolio expansion,” K-One said.
