CSR Program - MyJanji

On 1 November 2018, K-One launched MyJanji, a CSR program to help needy, underprivileged and disadvantaged individuals and familes. The program supports applicants nationwide, but due consideration would be given to applicants from the neighborhoods where the Group predominantly operates.

The MyJanji Committee, spearheaded by the People Manager comprises of K-One staff from various backgrounds was established to manage the program in a fair manner. The Committee assesses suitable and deserving applicants eligible for a sponsorhip of RM300 per month over one year based on a number of set requirements which includes financial capability, family support, health condition, age and dependents. Regular visits are made throughout the duration of the program to foster a closer relationship with successful candidates and to ensure the sponsorship provided is able to alleviate some of their financial burden.

To date, the Committee has successfully granted two individuals i.e. Madam Wong Wai Fong and Madam Lam Thi My Tien sponsorships for the duration of one year ending 1 Oct 2019. Madam Lam Thi My Tien is a widow whose only child has a heart ailment. She works hard to cover her family's living and medical expenses by selling fruits and snacks. Madam Wong Wai Fong on the other hand, is an elderly lady with no dependable source of financial support for her to carry on through her golden years.

K-One sympathises with both women and is glad it is able to assist them financially. K-One is keen to contribute towards improving the quality of life for the broader community and hopes that the MyJanji program continues to touch the lives of needy, underprivileged and disadvantaged Malaysians.
