K-One's Medkaire Ventilator showcased in Annual Scientific Congress 2022

Medkaire ventilator, first made in Malaysia ventilator licensed by NASA-JPL was showcased in the Annual Scientific Congress 2022 organised by the Malaysian Society of Anaesthesiologists and the College of Anaesthesiologists. The event was held from 5 - 7 August 2022 at the Shangri-La Hotel, Kuala Lumpur.

K-One took the opportunity to exhibit the Medkaire ventilator in this prestigious medical/healthcare event with the objective to soft launch and introduce it to doctors, particularly those specializing in anaesthesia and intensive care, medical academics, healthcare authorities and related parties in the medical field. We showcased a "live" test of the Michigan Instrument Lung Simulator in conjunction with the Medkaire ventilator based on NASA-JPL's original design and a K-One facelift model which incorporates a digital touchscreen.
