## CSR Activity- Promoting Safety on Campus

As Malaysia recently faces a fresh wave of COVID-19 cases following the discovery of the Omicron XBB sub-variant as confirmed by our Health Minister, YB Khairy Jamaluddin in his press conference on 31 October 2022, the K-One Group's (K-One) CSR team sprung into action.

On 15 November 2022, our CSR Team visited Universiti Tunku Abdul Rahman (UTAR) and Tunku Abdul Rahman University of Management and Technology (TARUMT) in Kampar, Perak to sponsor 2,100 COVID-19 Antigen self-test kits for each university to be distributed to students who are likely more susceptible to contract or spread the virus as they are more active and tend to be in enclosed areas such as lecture rooms.

In UTAR, the 2,100 self-test kits were handed over to Mr. Andrew Lim from the Department of Alumni Relations and Placement which will be distributed to the students and staff respectively.

After the meeting at UTAR, the CSR team visited TARUMT, which is located beside the UTAR campus. The CSR team was welcomed by Dr. Joanne Yim, TARUMT Perak Campus Head, and Mr. Ganesa from the Administration and Sports Department. K-One similarly sponsored 2,100 COVID-19 Antigen self-test kits for distribution to their students and staff alike. These self-test kits will be extremely useful and timely as there will be a new intake of students as well as the start of a new semester for existing undergrads on 21 November 2022.
